BRENT RUN TO THE DUNNY CURRIE – Don't run behind this horse! He has had a recent form slump probably due to being out on a spell as a kept man. He once wore blue and played with tasers and missed it so much he is soon going to play with them again. He was another one in the top 8 last year so could be one to watch.



KELVIN ATOR BOYTE – A very cool chestnut who uses his head. He has a \$1000 drop thanks to a local trainer. He can sometimes get worked up but doesn't often get worked over. Just ask Linda.



CHRIS SPREAD EAGLED BURNELL – Likes a left hand track. Likes to box in other runners and sometimes clips heels and nose dives to the ground. Doesn't give in and will be trying to the end. Definitely a chance.



BRENDON SMART DRIVE CLEAVER – This is the first time in the final 8 for this colt. He likes to agitate his opponents and put them into a spin. Hopefully he won't get washed out towards the end and foam at the mouth. His usual jockey is last years runner Kaye High Heels Cleaver. As long as Kaye rides him right and doesn't put him

through the wringer he will be a chance.



PETER RABBIT PIE BAKER – Like to run on the post and rails. He is quick out of the gates but is known to run erratically at times. If he can put his hammer down and not shy at his own shadow, he will have the finishing POST in his sights.



CRAIG LESTER PIGGOTT – This young colt is backed by a large syndicate on every race day appearance. He will be well groomed going into this race. He is still being broken in. If he wears blinkers to avoid being distracted by young fillies on the other side of the fence, he will do well.



CALLUM HUG A RANGA DAVID – This young chestnut comes from a strong line of chestnuts. Another one that prefers a left hand track. He has good form and has gained alot of experience from a number of different tracks this year. He was in the top 8 last year and has a favourable handicap. Watch.
